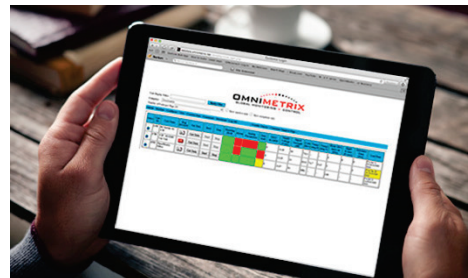

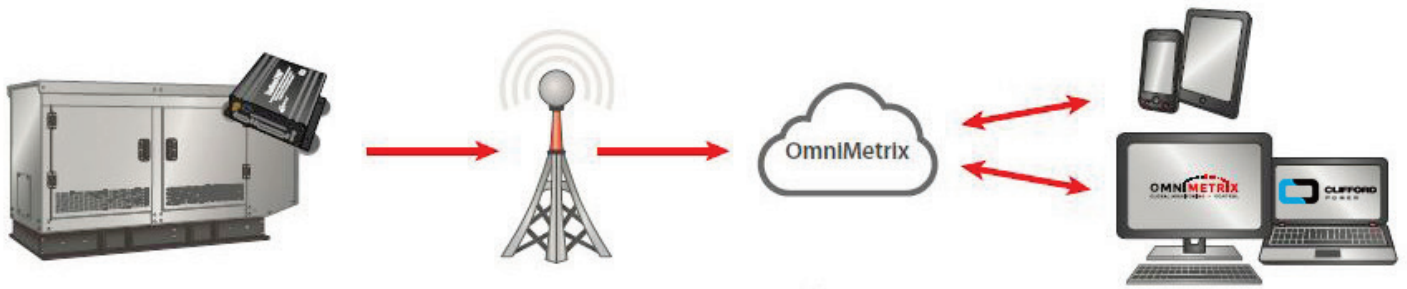

How it works

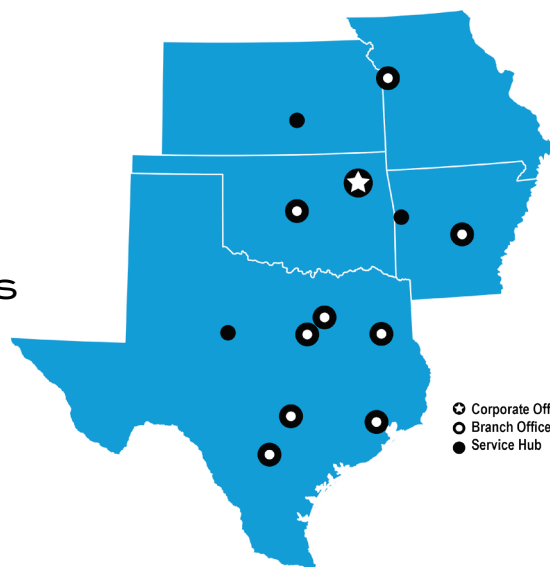
Once the monitor is installed on your generator, it will collect data 24/7 via cellular connection (or optional satellite). In the event of a problem, it will alert the appropriate party via email or text. Reports and status can also be viewed on your desktop, tablet, or smartphone.



Real-Time Alerts Prevent Untimely Equipment Failures

1. The monitor will send Alerts to your designated points-of-contact via email or text.
 - Receive critical alerts: Generator Faults, Loss of Communications, and Failure to Exercise.
 - If equipped, receive alerts for Low Fuel Level.
1. The monitoring portal allows you to evaluate the generator status anytime via desktop, tablet, or smartphone.
 - Receive optional weekly or monthly status reports.
 - The monitoring portal also allows you to remotely test-run the generator.
